# Accommodation & Dive Packages

## Overview

Ideally suited for guests joining a Central Atolls, Malé to Malé itinerary on Maldives Master, we are happy to be able to offer dive and accommodation packages in association with Pelagic Divers in Fuvahmulah enabling you to experience the amazing shark diversity and encounters that the area is famous for.

### Fuvahmulah Atoll

This solitary island atoll, also commonly called Fomulac or Foammulah Atoll, lies within the Equatorial Channel between Huvadhoon Atoll and Addu Atoll in the southernmost part of the Maldives. Unlike other atolls, there are no thilas, giris or kandus; It consists of a continuous, low-lying coral formation that spans 4.5 km in length, is 1.2 km wide and extends deep towards the ocean floor.

Designated as a [UNESCO Biosphere Reserve](#), Fuvahmulah boasts the most diverse coral ecosystems in the country, and also has the reputation of being 'the most beautiful island in the Maldives'.

Its location and underwater topography make Fuvahmulah and the surrounding waters home to a rare combination of pelagic marine life. Pristine, colourful hard corals entirely cover the top reef and the walls that drop off to the well beyond the limits of recreational diving. But, what sets this unique, single island atoll apart from others are its resident tiger sharks, as well as sightings of thresher sharks, silver tip and white tip sharks and even scalloped hammerheads, resulting in it also being known as Maldives Shark Island.

Fuvahmulah is essentially one big dive site with the main diving areas being Tiger Harbour, the North and South points. Diving at these locations is dependent on weather and sea conditions but, regardless of which dive site(s) you visit, you will be able to see all kinds of marine life despite doing multiple dives within the same area.

### Accommodation

The 4-star-rated Ataraxis Grand & Spa, located on the Northern shore of the Fuvahmulah, offers rooms and facilities comparable to some of the best dive resorts in the Maldives.

Designed with relaxation and comfort in mind, Ataraxis Grand and Spa offers guests a homely environment with warm earthy tones and cosy layouts. The in-house restaurant serves both local delicacies and international cuisine. Ataraxis also offers guests in-house gym facilities, along with a spa and sauna located at the top deck.



The Spot restaurant, located on the ground floor, offers an enticing culinary experience with diverse cuisine made with fresh, seasonal ingredients. Talented chefs create delectable dishes for breakfast, lunch, and dinner, catering to both international and local tastes.

The Top Deck provides the perfect location to sit back and relax with a selection of appetisers, light snacks and refreshing beverages available from the rooftop cafe' while watching the sunset over the cerulean ocean.

All rooms feature either a double bed or 2 single beds with air-conditioning, a safe deposit box, a hairdryer, an ensuite bathroom with rain shower, a mini bar, blackout curtains and satellite TV. Other in-room amenities include complimentary drinking water and toiletries, tea and coffee-making facilities and an iron.
