

# Munda Hotel Suggestions

Following are some accommodation options in Munda, Western Province. We provide these as suggestions based on a good record with past guests who have stayed there. Prices are approximate and are intended as a guide only.

### Agnes Gateway Hotel

Originally called Agnes Lodge, this family owned hotel offers Anglo-Solomons hospitality in typical pacific style surroundings. Located a few minutes walk from Munda Airport and overlooking Roviana Lagoon, Agnes Gateway Hotel offers a restaurant, bar, private beach area and jetty where you will find Dive Munda's home base. Other amenities include a shared lounge, TV in common areas, tour desk, laundry and ironing service. WiFi access is available in some public areas (charges apply) and every room has a private bathroom with a shower. Most rooms also have air conditioning as well as fans and are equipped with a mini-fridge and kettle.

### Zipolo Habu Resort

Located 25 minutes by boat from Munda on Lola Island in Vona Vona Lagoon, Zipolo Habu Resort provides an authentic island living experience in traditionally styled and built accommodation, without compromising on the comforts of home. Nestled within a perfect blue lagoon and fringed by white sands and tall green palms, Lola truly reflects a quintessential island paradise.

The resort is the result of many years of hard work by the owners who, along with their children, designed a place for those keen to enjoy a true pacific island experience.





Constructed using traditional Vona Vona building materials of Sago Palm Leaf, Lawyer Cane and Wild Betelnut Tree, all of the bungalows have 240V power, fans and a kitchenette equipped with a gas stove, refrigerator/freezer and cooking utensils. Fresh rain water is provided, along with tea and coffee making facilities. Mosquito nets are provided in each bedroom, although they are seldom needed and all bathrooms have hot water systems.

The two Deluxe Bungalows are located near the water's edge and have private en-suite bathrooms, whilst the semi-deluxe bungalows are set a little further back amongst the trees and utilise shared toilet and shower facilities conveniently located (in a building) amongst flowering orchids and frangipani.





For the ultimate comfort and luxury, the four beach cabins are fitted with air-conditioning and feature a well appointed private bathroom, kitchenette and lounge area. Located right on the beach, each has its own veranda with comfy chairs affording full sea and sunset views.

### Castaway Lagoon Resort

Situated on Hobupeka Island, just 2 minutes by boat from Munda jetty, Castaway Lagoon Resort is a true lagoon hideaway. The 4 traditionally designed, air-conditioned bungalows, are comfortably furnished with modern fittings including private ensuite bathroom with hot & cold water shower. Each bungalow has a double and single bed, well ventilated high ceiling, wall-mounted fans, mini-fridge, tea and coffee making facilities and a small verandah to relax and enjoy the peace and tranquillity while taking in the stunning views across the lagoon.









The resort's newly built Whitehouse Seaview Rooms offer more basic accommodation consisting of 4 fan-cooled, self-contained rooms with private ensuite and either 1 double and 1 single bed or 3 single beds. 2 rooms are interconnecting to accommodate families.

There is also a beachfront bar/ restaurant serving a variety of meals and drinks. Land and water tours, including fishing trips can also be arranged at the resort.

## Titiru Eco Lodge

Stay in an idyllic location and get back to nature.

Titiru Eco Lodge lies between Egholo and Ugele Villages on the northern shore of Rendova Island, 45 minutes by boat from Munda.



The tropical island setting provides a peaceful and relaxing atmosphere, while a variety of daily activities offer guests the opportunity to learn about Solomon's culture and customs as well as observing local flora and fauna.

The beautiful surroundings offer plenty to keep guests intrigued, including forest walks, paddling dugout canoes on Saqiri Cove, night crabbing, fishing and the local bamboo band.

A visit to one of the local villages provides the opportunity to meet and interact with the locals and learn how to basket weave, buy traditional wood carved items, go eel fish feeding and bird watching.

For the more energetic, the Lodge can organise a Rendova Peak Tour which includes mountain climbing, old tabu sights, old village sites, and fantastic panoramic views of the surrounding islands.

The guest accommodations, fringed by lush forests, are situated in the garden, on the shoreline and overwater amongst the mangroves of Saqiri Cove with its fish and bird sanctuary. The traditionally designed, solidly constructed bungalows provide simple but comfortable accommodation with power supplied from a solar power system, all in keeping with the natural surroundings and eco-lodge ethos.
