What is Pack for a purpose?



Pack for a Purpose is an initiative that allows travellers, like you, to make a lasting impact in the countries you visit. It allows you to make a meaningful contribution to the destination you visit. We are fortunate enough to travel and have the chance to visit really remote areas. The communities who welcome us often have very little. So by bringing something, it is a way of expressing appreciation for the experiences and hospitality you will enjoy.

Pack for a Purpose works with hundreds of businesses, travel agents and tour companies across the globe. These partners identify local challenges in the countries they operate in. These might be related to the environment, education, health, child welfare, animal welfare, senior welfare or socio-economic development. The partners can then choose to support existing structures (like helping an orphanage) or create their own project (planting new trees for example).

You, as a traveller, diver, and tourist can help! Simply head over to the <u>Pack for a Purpose</u> <u>website</u> and select your destination. You will then be able to see the participating accommodation and/ or tour company in your chosen area and the project(s) they are supporting.

Choose the supplies you wish to take from the specific items requested and make space in your suitcase. It does not have to be big or heavy! Once you are in the country, just drop off the items and they will be delivered to the project. Your contribution, no matter how small, can make a difference and may mean the world to someone else. If you can spare just a few kilos of space in your suitcase to take supplies for schools or medical clinics in need, you'll make a priceless impact in the lives of local children and families.

What about Pack for a Purpose in the Solomons?

The Solomon Islands Literacy League

The Solomon Islands Literacy League is committed to bringing books and learning materials to communities throughout the Solomon Islands. With limited public reading facilities, and reading materials often not present in the home, it is no surprise that literacy rates in Solomon Islands are under 20 percent. Outside the capital of Honiara, books and magazines become even more scarce and much prized possessions, with everyone even treasuring newspapers no matter how many weeks old they may be.

This is the situation that drives the passion of literacy advocate Joyce Boykin. Originally from the USA, Joyce has been living and working in Solomon Islands for the past 22 years, firstly as a teacher, and then as a developer of education programs. In 2014 she coordinated many projects, such as distributing 36,000 school readers, sourcing 19,000 primary school books, and creating the Literacy League to assist teachers use the new resources.

List of specific items needed:

Books:

Adult Fiction, Adult Non-Fiction ('How-To Books', Biographies, Books to Inspire, Educate, Open Minds, Help with Enterprise Development, etc.), Children's Storybooks, Early Childhood Development, 'Learning-to-Read' Books, Young Adult Fiction and Non-Fiction, and Young Readers and Teenage Fiction

Reference Materials:

Atlases Current, Dictionaries, Thesaurus, Age Appropriate Encyclopaedias (Current) on CD.

Library Supplies:

Ballpoint Pens, Book Pockets for Date Issued Cards, Clear Packing Tape, Clear Sellotape, Date Issued Cards, Date Stamp and Inkpad, Due-Date Slip (to remind readers when to return books), Erasers, Paper-Cutting Knife, Plastic Covers for Books, Retractable Pencils, Ruler, and Scissors
